

WINTER Checklist

Important to Know

Extreme winter weather can strike any part of the country. Icy streets and highways, deep drifting snow, high winds, low visibility, and piercing, bitter cold can be dangerous—even life-threatening. Here are some simple prep solutions to help when the weather turns frightful.

1 Let there be light when power fails. Have power failure lighting, candles, and LED Flashlights for when the lights go out.

2 Protect your water supply. Wrap exterior pipes and store water for when mains break.

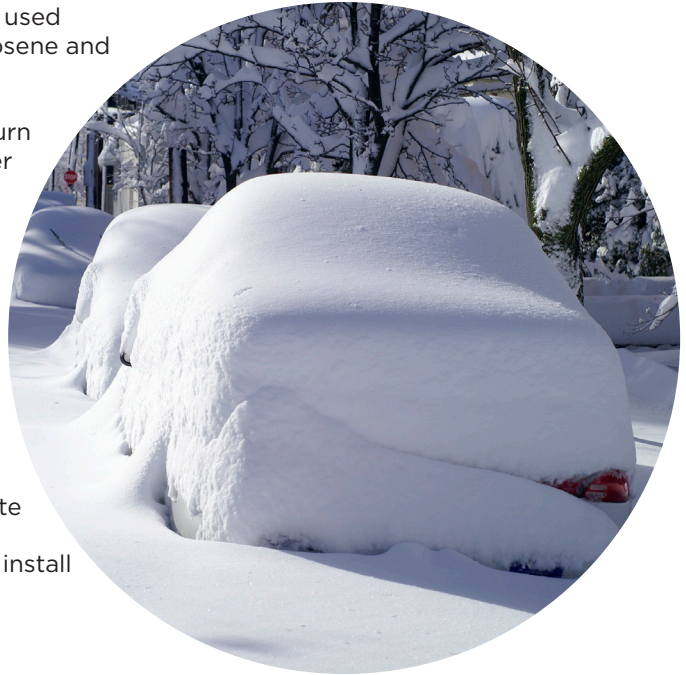
3 Avoid frostbite and hypothermia. Wear a coat, hat, gloves, and scarf over loose-fitting layers.

4 Keep your home fires burning during power failures, used fireplaces or certified kerosene and propane heaters.

5 Be careful and don't burn down your home. Never leave fireplaces or space heaters unattended, especially while sleeping.

6 Don't slip, slide, fall or crash. Store ice melt and good shoes for you, kitty litter and tire chains for the car.

7 Carbon Monoxide is the silent killer. Ventilate when using fireplaces or fueled space heaters, and install CO sensors.
