

A meeting of the Ventnor City Board of Recreation was called to order by Chairman Beck at 6:35 pm. On April 10, 2007 at our recreation building located in Ventnor Heights at Surrey and Balfour Avenues in accordance with the Sunshine Law.

Guests; Debbie Nehmad, Quan Nguyen, Dan Clower to talk about Volleyball. Mrs. Nehmad was here as in previous years to talk about the Volleyball Tournament she has ran for the past 20 years. Hers would be June 30 & July 1 weekend. She did mention that of course monies would be donated as in the past to the same organizations. Also the summer league she had some concerns they are: the lights were not working last year at the volleyball courts also how much of them would be taken away for the “new” proposed playground at Somerset Ave. These 2 questions would be directed to the Recreation Director, Mr. Thomas for when he returns from his vacation.

Made a suggestion that if lights were not going to be fixed that possibly they could move the tournaments and league to the fishing pier. This is a consideration stated Chairman Beck but he would pass on this info to Director Thomas and he would be in touch with her—also the recreation calendar would have to be checked for any conflicts.

Mr. Nguyen and Mr. Clower were here to present a separate special events application for various volleyball tournaments throughout the summer. There are 6 dates but if need be and they are only allowed a few they these are what they would want, one being most important: 1. June 16& 17, 2. July 12 & 22, 3. July 28 & 29, 4. August 18 & 19. A donation would be made to the Atlantic County Riding Center. These is no other money made the fees go directly back to the tournaments either for prizes or in the donation made. These are all of course separate from the tournament Mrs. Nehmad runs every year.

Chairman Beck also stated that the board could not promise all of the tournaments and even if approved possibly not both days. The gentlemen stated that they would want them to be for the Saturdays if a choice had to be made and not the Sunday. Again all these things would have to be discussed with the Director and then he would call them back with arrangements. After that all fees and insurances would have to be obtained before any approvals would be made.

Chairman noted that the Hutch Basketball season is over and went very well. Trophies were given our and all the paperwork for referrers and workers was submitted for payment to city hall. Little League begins on April 16<sup>th</sup>.

A Motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Debbie Beirne and seconded by John Gallagher.
