OUTREACH PROJECT FOR REPETITIVE LOSS

Dear Resident:

You have received this mailing because the entire City of Ventnor has been designated as a repetitive loss area and is prone to flooding.

- 1) Check with the Building Department on the extent of past flooding and future protection.
- 2) Prepare for flooding:
 - a. *shut off electricity and gas to your house when a flood comes.
 - b. *make a list of emergency numbers and identify a safe place to go. Have a plan to evacuate your pets.
- 3) Consider some permanent flood protection measures:
 - a. *consider elevating your house above flood levels.
 - **b.** *more information can be found at FEMA's website, www.ready.gov/floods.
- 4) Talk to the Building Department for information on financial assistance:
 - a. *Get a flood insurance policy, it will help pay for repairs after a flood and in some cases, it will help pay the costs of
 - a. Elevating a substantially damaged building.
- 5) Get a flood insurance policy:
 - a. *Homeowner's insurance policies do not cover flood damage. *Contact your insurance agent for more information

10 PRIORITY TOPICS

- 1) Know your hazard:
 - a. *Your property is subject to flooding and is in a repetitive flooded area.
- 2) Insure your property for your flood hazard:
 - a. *Obtain flood insurance. *Renters should buy flood insurance for their contents.
- 3) Protect people from the hazard:
 - a. *Turn around, don't drown.
 - b. *Designate a safe place after an evacuation order is issued.
- 4) Protect your property from the hazard:
 - a. *We can give you information on home elevation, call (609)823-7987, Ventnor City Building Department.
 - b. *Replace your flooded mechanical items with elevated ones.
- 5) Build responsibly:
 - a. *Get a permit from Ventnor Building Department.
 - b. *Know the Substantial Damage rules and ICC benefits, visit Ventnor City Building Department, 6201 Atlantic Avenue, Ventnor, New Jersey.
- 6) Protect natural floodplain function:
 - a. *Do not dump in storm drains/report broken silt fences.
- 7) Hurricane preparedness:

a. *Know your evacuation route, visit www.ventnorcity.org.

8) General preparedness:

a. *Inventory and photograph your home and keep insurance papers and insurance policies in a safe place.

9) Basement flooding:

a. *Check downspouts and drain away from house.

10) Flood Education:

a. *Educate school children about flooding.
