What is CERT?

Training of a <u>volunteer</u> civilian emergency work force.

Members of CERT act as an adjunct to public emergency services during major disasters. When emergencies happen, CERT members can give critical support to first responders and provide immediate assistance to victims. CERT members can also assist with non-emergency projects that help improve the safety of the community.
